Practice Transformation for Physicians and Health Care Teams (formerly called *Better Diabetes Care*) is a free online resource designed for health care professionals and administrators who want to change systems of health care delivery around diabetes.

Practice change is essential to provide evidence-based care recommended by the Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) model and to manage issues related to diabetes and its complications. This resource provides models, links, and tools to help physicians and health care teams initiate and maintain quality improvements in their health care practice.
